Treasurer:

- Maggie went over treasurer report. Spent \$175.00 over budget for culture day? Over budget for culture day...came out of assemblies.
- Fall \$500.00 for students proposals. Spring \$500.00 use for classroom type things.
 - Students came in and gave presentations for their class to tell what they would use money for. Mrs. Brown's class (Boys) wanted to use money for personalized pencils. This is just for 6th grade. Would need 72 pencils per classroom and the cost would be \$149.30. Tax \$9.00 and shipping is free.

Need foil \$11.10, Parachute and candy \$20.00 (would ask for donated candy first), rubber bands \$5.70, pipe cleaners \$3.30. Need \$100.00 donated to Shircliff. Students thought you might be able to reuse every year. Maggie thought it probably would not reusable for the next year.
- PTO members at the meeting took a vote and the motion was approved for the fall student proposals. We approved to reimburse with receipts up to what they asked for.

Principal's Report:

- Mrs. Brock thanked everyone for being here.
- She also wanted to thank us for the conference dinner. The teachers appreciate it.
- Thanked Julie and Emily for going listening to spring dance ideas from the students.
 - o Galaxy theme won 5th grade based competition.
- Thanked Emily for hanging up flags for culture day.
 - o Culture day celebration of nations. Griffin Caron, Adith Meruga, Andrew Pasternak.
- Veteran's day. Pulling kids out for practice....most of the time was spent on how to get the students on and off the risers.
- Will send agenda out soon.
- Dojo is changing. Will happen at the beginning of the calendar year.
 - Open communication with parents. Parents should hear from teachers first before principals if there is a behavior situation.
 - o Grade level specific. Dojo more information.
- Rocket reward: 3rd graders love everything. 6th graders don't. 6th graders to like the homework pass.
 - Parents don't like pop as a reward but students love it!
- Teachers are doing well with station rotation/flip classrooms.
- Hurricane and coat drive. Want students to be problem solvers in every way not just at school.

President's Report:

- Met with Chris Passarge and Mrs. Brock. PTO ready to purchase equipment.
 - o Purchase and store at district.
 - Purchase now to get price that was quoted. If we wait until resurfacing is finished the price will go up.
 - o To resurface Endeavor it would cost \$32,000.00 and district is paying.
 - District not sure what kind of expenses will be incurred over the winter.
 - Good idea what the budget will look like.
 - If not done in spring it will be done over the summer.
 - Prioritize: Needs and wants list at the district.
 - Takes 2 to 3 years for any school to get playground done.
 - Equipment goes up 3% after January 1st.
 - Insulation does not go up.
 - o Final cost \$34,228.26 which includes instillation.
- Took a vote to purchase playground equipment. Motion approved unanimously.

 Julie Gryder plans to get an easel of pictures for display coming soon playground....spring/summer. 1 week to install surfacing and equipment.
