

Endeavor PTO Minutes

Wednesday February 19, 2020

Meeting called to order at 9:25 am

Treasurer Report: Endeavor night out made \$360. Talent show brought in more money than what was spent. Received \$20 for spirit wear. See financial report

Student proposals were presented: there were 2 requests. One for several items from the STARS class, Jeffery presented. Total amount requested \$435. Tyler from Mrs. Adams class made presentation, requesting \$86 for materials. Vote was taken, approved to grant both proposals. Total was over the \$500 allocated for Spring, but only approx. \$250 was distributed in the fall for proposals.
