

Endeavor PTO Minutes

Meeting called to order at 9:20 am

Treasurer Report: Received a quarterly Kroger Rewards check for \$654.76, \$124 for spirit sticks. Only expenses were \$40.54 for Club 6, \$127.44 for teacher reimbursements. See financial report

Principal's reports: Mrs. Brock gave update on the playground. Will be installed over Spring Break. She discussed the District's Remote Learning Drill- in order to prepare for possible long term closures of schools due to Coronavirus pandemic. As of today, there are no cancellations of any PTO events, but that could change. Will collaborate with administration on rescheduling as able. State of the Schools was scheduled for today, but is postponed. Mrs. Brock updated on Pi Day event- Mrs. Shircliff presented her rock collection, said it was a good turnout. Discussed Mindfulness Matters- teachers are doing a PD in the morning on Mindfulness. Also discussed looking into signing up for Mindful Music for next school year, applying for grant if possible.

Presidents report: Discussed doing a ribbon cutting at recess for each grade when they come out once playground is approved for play. Julie asked that board members and those in chair positions let us know if they want to continue that position for next school year. Discussed looking into Follett Book fairs vs. Scholastic. Barb and Katie will get details. They also reported that with the money from the last book fair lots of books and gadgets were purchased for the Hub and teachers rooms. Brought up idea of doing a bake sale on Election Day in November, ask Hamilton for water donation.
